

5th Annual Adirondack District (AAU) Spring League for Girls Basketball
Tournament Rules and Coordinating Instructions

Home team will be responsible for keeping the official or “home” book.

No 30-second clock...ten second backcourt rule is in effect.

Maximum of 5 minutes for pre-game warm-up...more if time allows at the discretion of the site director or his designated site coordinator.

Games will consist of two 22.5 minutes halves (run time) stop time the last minute of each half.

Four timeouts per game...no minimum per half...4 @ 30 seconds.

Three minute half time.

Protests will be decided by the officials.

Shooting fouls...2 shot penalty after 10 team fouls, no one and one. Players can move on the release of the shot.

5 second violation (held ball) violation in effect...i.e. holding the ball for 5 sec in the front court.

Overtime...2 minutes per O/T. Additional O/T's are 1 minute and will be sudden death.

Abusive languages by coaches, players and/or parents and other spectators will not be tolerated. Those using same are subject to immediate ejection from the game site...not just the game in which the misuse occurs.

The home team coach is responsible for reporting to the league director, the results and game score for each game, via e-mail, within 72 hours after its completion.
